Non-Tenure Track, Instructor/Senior Instructor Faculty Position

The University of South Alabama invites applications for a non-tenure track, 12-month faculty position at the rank of Instructor or Senior Instructor in the Department of Radiologic Sciences.

Applicants for the rank of Instructor must have at least a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution, current ARRT certification in radiography and 3 years of clinical experience in diagnostic radiography. Applicants without a Master's degree in a related field are required to have a minimum of 18 hours of graduate coursework and obtain their Master's degree within 1 year (12 months) of hire date to be considered for this position.

To be considered for the rank of Senior Instructor, the applicant must have a Master's degree in a related field, a minimum of 7 years, full-time teaching experience in a JRCERT accredited program, post-primary certification in and advanced modality, and demonstrate active participation in professional organizations.

Primary duties include didactic instruction, supervision of students, and clinical practice. The position is a full-time, non-tenure track position.
